- The board approved new membership applications and withdrawals for electric service.
- The board appointed voting delegates/alternates for the Federated, NCSC, and CFC Annual Meetings at New York City.
- o The board reviewed the annual CFC Officer's Compliance Worksheet and Certificate.
- The board reviewed employee policies #1505 Work Breaks; #1506 Lunch; and #1507 Wage and Salary Plan.
- The board authorized filing of corporate tax returns for calendar year 2024 prepared in accordance with standard accounting practices by the cooperative's auditing firm, CliftonLarsonAllen, LLP.
- The board approved the appointment of a board member to the Loan Review Committee and reviewed committee assignments for April 2025-March 2026.
- The board approved a Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) application for a community-based business in the cooperative's service area.
- The board approved membership of the Buchanan County Economic Development Commission with dues of \$500.
- The board adopted a resolution in recognition of retiring Director Steve Boevers.
- The board reviewed the cooperative's operating and financial statements through March 2025.
