EnergyWise Renewables Established in 2006, Butler County REC's EnergyWise Renewables program gives members the opportunity to support member-owned renewable energy projects in its service territory. This program includes support of any type of distributed generation that provides an alternative or enhancement to the traditional electric power system. All contributions go to support small-scale distributed generation. There is no charge for the administration of the program. To participate in the voluntary program, contact us.

Low-Income Home Energy Assistance (LIHEAP) LIHEAP is a federally funded program that assists low-income families by providing a one-time payment to their heating utility. Home-owners and renters meeting the income guidelines are eligible. Applications are accepted by your local community action outreach office on a first-come, first-serve basis from Nov-ember 1-April 30 of each year. Contact your local agency or give us a call for more information.

RECare Butler County's RECare program provides local community action agencies with resources to help low-income members pay for winter heating bills. Each co-op family may receive up to \$200 per year for heating assistance or up to \$400 per year for families with all-electric home heating. To support the program, contributions are made by co-op families. One-time contributions or monthly contributions added onto electric bills are possible.
